The Challenge

With four Texas offices and more than 50 jobs in progress at any given time, Joeris General Contractors creates, edits and shares a lot of content. Terabytes of design files, CAD drawings, contracts, photos and documents can put a strain on any company's file storage architecture and Joeris reached the limits of their single file server quickly when they began growing rapidly.

"We were behind in our IT initiatives and wanted to be up to date and more competitive," said Joeris IT Manager Tom Crews. "It was cumbersome for end users to gain file access. We had a single Windows File Server that was hosted on premises and access required VPN or a terminal server login."

The reliance on email attachments prevented IT from having visibility into how data was being shared and did not allow them the ability to properly provision access to the people who needed it. File versioning was a constant issue with a heavy reliance on email attachments (many containing sensitive information) for file sharing.

While secure collaboration was an issue, Joeris' largest concern was around lack of access when there was limited or no internet connectivity on job sites, which, coupled with the hassles of a VPN, would slow production and risk job completion.

The Solution

After trying other content platforms like Box and Dropbox, Joeris still couldn't provide file access without an internet connection. It was essential that they find a solution with the option for hybrid deployment to enable teams to access, edit and share files on any device, from anywhere.

Egnyte's hybrid solution ensures files are available for teams when WiFi isn't reliable. Joeris uses Egnyte Storage Sync devices in their on-site trailers so users can sync specific job folders to their mobile devices for quick file access. The Egnyte mobile app gives teams a convenient way to access a central repository for all project files, while assuring that when users make edits, only the changes are saved – minimizing the strain on bandwidth.

By getting rid of costly on-premises file servers, Joeris was also able to reduce costs by replacing their VPN and FileBrowser app, a file manager/virtual USB drive many teams were using on their mobile devices. Egnyte makes Joeris users more efficient with a centralized content platform that reduces the amount of work they have to do.
